<p>1st – 12th</p> <p>Redoing work for a higher grade is considered “grade grace.”</p> <p>Teacher & student will review work, discuss any do overs, set a timeline date (PLACED ON THE PAPER AND IN GRADEBOOK) for completion and return. The onus for completion and returns for an improved grade is <u>on the student</u>.</p>	<p>All 6 Weeks</p> <p>Parent Portal Letters are provided to parents with access codes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A number grade will be given and report cards are viewable on parent portal. <u>Each core class will post no fewer than 2 grades per week.</u> <u>1st -5th ONLY: One grade may be posted weekly in non-core classes</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Science/Social Studies/Art/PE</u> No 6 weeks average will end in a 9. The exception to this rule is a 99. This rule does not apply to semester averages. Grades will be averaged 60% daily and 40% test. There may be no fewer than two or more test grades each 6 weeks. However, in certain circumstances the final grade can be derived from only daily work. <i>At no time may a teacher use only 1-test grade within any six weeks as this would be 40% of the students’ grade.</i> Teachers will note accommodations, missing grades, redo’s and corrected work in their grade books. This allows parents and students an opportunity to see grade adjustments, academic needs, modifications and support. For test grades below 70, the student will be given another opportunity to take the test for a grade up to 70, unless the test was open book and/or open notes (no such option is available). Further students and teacher will agree, by their signatures on the work to be corrected the acceptable time frame for this correction. Failure on the part of the student to comply will result in no higher grade than a 50. Daily work redos will be at the discretion of the teacher. No grade will be placed in the gradebook below a 50; <u>UNLESS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the student was guilty of cheating (cheating has its own penalty; it is a zero) and/or <u>the student refuses</u> to take responsibility, within the allotted time frame, to change the grade. The principal may be included in this decision if deemed necessary. <i>Make- up work</i> students will be given the number of days absent to make up all work assigned during the absence. <u>Grades will be updated on Monday of each school week.</u> <u>Report cards will be sent home each 6 weeks.</u>
